

Marina safety and information

ALL PERSONS USING THESE PREMISES DO SO AT THEIR OWN RISK

Please read the following information regarding our pontoon and marina safety measures ye something...

- Please familiarise yourself with the closest safety ladders so that you know where they are in an emergency.
- There are fire extinguishers on the pontoons, please don't operate these without management being made aware. IN THE CASE OF A FIRE IT IS IMPORTANT TO RAISE THE ALARM AND INFORM STAFF ONSITE AT THE TIME.
- There are life rings and throwing lines placed around the pontoon, again we ask that you familiarize yourself with the location of these.
- We have first aid kits available at the marina reception, please report any incidents at our reception.
- There are 2 defibrillators onsite, one at The Chartroom Bar and Restaurant and another at the Marina Reception. These are marked on the marina map and it is wise to familiarize yourself with their locations.
- Kip Marina recommend the use of lifejackets at all times when on the pontoons, this is for your own safety and that of others.
- Dogs must be kept on leads at all times and are allowed on the pontoons at the owners risk.
- Kip Marina ask that you do not cycle on the pontoons at any time.
- Please always return trolleys to the gangway heads after use so the pontoons are kept clear from trip hazards.
 Beware pontoons slippery when wet
